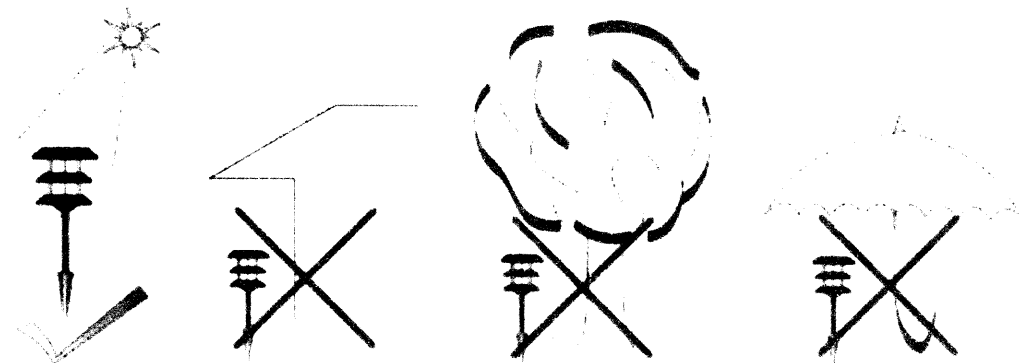

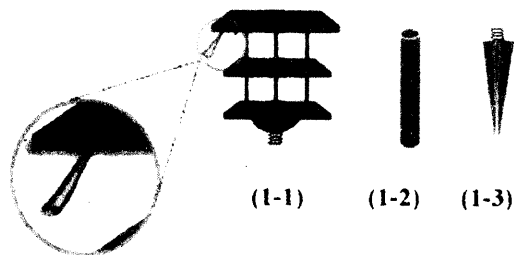
IMPORTANT: The Hampton Bay solar light should be installed in an area that gets direct sunlight. Your Hampton Bay solar light can run up to 8-10 hours when it is installed in an area which is free from cover, shade, or shadowing. Note that if it is placed in a shadowed area, the performance may be dramatically reduced.



Step 1: Unpack (Figure 1)

Unpack the solar light and you should have the following items:

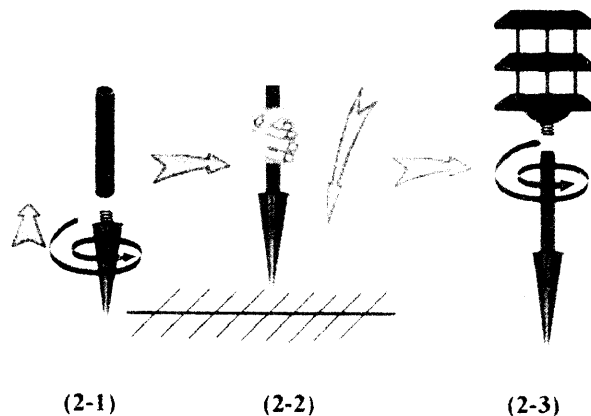
- 1-1. Head assembly
- 1-2. Post
- 1-3. Stake

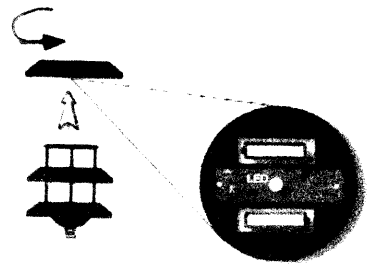
Step 2: Assembly (Figure 2)

- ☼ Thread the stake into post; make sure it goes all the way down. (Figure 2-1)
 - ☼ Position the stake-post assembly into ground by pressing the post by hand. (Figure 2-2)
 - ☼ Thread the solar head assembly into stake-post assembly; make sure it goes all the way down. (Figure 2-3)
- Note: Do not press down on the top of head, which may cause damage to the head assembly. (Figure 2-3)**
- ☼ Remove the battery isolators by pulling out the plastic strip from the bottom of head assembly. (Figure 1-1)

Note: If you encounter difficulty when installing the stake due to rocky or clay type soils, use a shovel to loosen the soil before installing the stake. Then attach the post and solar light to the stake. Do not hammer directly on the stake as this may damage the threads.

Replacing the batteries: (Figure 3-1)

Note: The batteries must be replaced with AA size rechargeable Ni-Cd or Ni-MH batteries.

IMPORTANT: For best performance, replace with rechargeable AA Ni-Cd or Ni-MH batteries every year.

To replace the batteries on your solar light, simply open the top head assembly by twisting it counter-clockwise, this will allow access to battery compartment. (Figure 3-1) Replace with two new AA size rechargeable Ni-Cd batteries. For best performance, use the same batch of batteries.

CAUTION: CONTAINS NICKEL-CADMIUM BATTERIES. BATTERY MUST BE RECYCLED OR DISPOSED OF PROPERLY.

Care of your solar lights:

The top lens should be cleaned periodically to help maintain optimum performance.

Troubleshooting:

Q: Light does not work.

- A: 1. Make sure the battery isolator has been moved.
 2. Battery connection may be loose. Make sure battery terminal connectors are tight.

Q: Short run time.

- A: 1. Inappropriate location. Solar light is powered by sunlight, it is very important to place the solar light under direct sunlight.
 2. Batteries may be dead. Replace with new batteries.

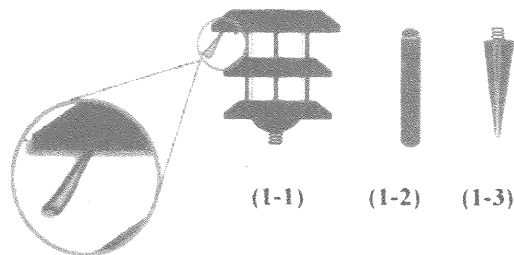

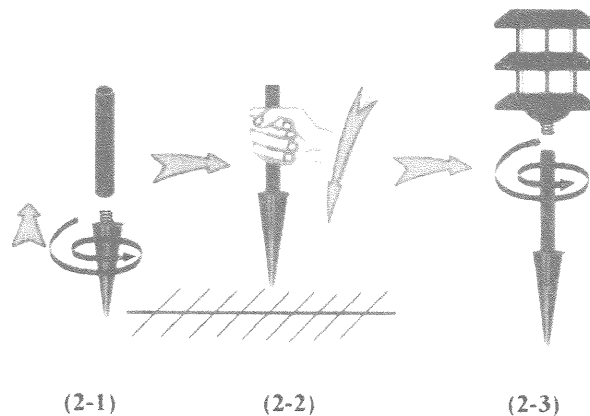

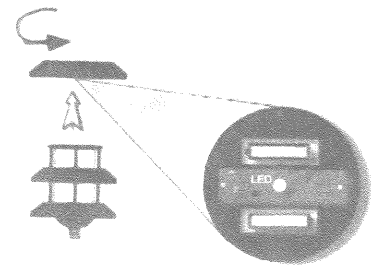
